

The meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. with the pledge to the flag. Bob Quillen, Ernie Bentley, Al Davis, Cliff Chase and Cindy Weingartz were all present at roll call.

There was one correction to the February 15, 2011 minutes. Chief Rob View gave the fire report not Assistant Chief Chipp. It was moved by Al Davis and supported by Ernie Bentley to approve the February 15 minutes with the correction. 5/yes, 0/no Motion carried

Bruce Reetz noted that STING Director Jeff Keister reported they had 300 local investigations within the year, 62 were in Ogemaw County. The DDA wants a letter of support to get an MDA grant for lighting in front of Brian's Fruit Market down to Walmart. The commissioners will write that letter. There will be a panel of 3 planning commissioners and 3 county commissioners to discuss zoning in regards to the wind turbines. The county audit has been reviewed and approved. The FFA kids did a demo on Asian carp for competition. A letter was received from Judge Baumgartner regarding security at the county building. They found 94 knives and 0 guns.

Diane Quillen reported that the libraries reading program went very well. They had over 800 kids participating. Mills Township wants to join the library district. The next Schwan Sale is April 2.

Bob Quillen reported income for February was \$5,640.94 and expenses were \$8,932.37 leaving a balance in all accounts at the end of February of \$72,095.69. It was moved by Bentley and supported by Davis to accept the Treasurer's Report. 5/yes, 0/no Motion carried

Weingartz received a letter from Paul Olson about the liability concerning the jail inmates. We are to contact him to put Ogemaw County on as additional insured for the projects. Another letter from the county clerk asking for a resolution of support for West Branch Regional Medical Center to amend a certificate of needs rules regarding cardiac services. Our board offered no support. Weingartz offered an updated pension resolution. Moved by Chase, supported by Davis to adopt the updated pension resolution. 5/yes, 0/no Motion carried Moved by Weingartz, supported by Chase to amend the budget adding \$900 to Fire Runs Revenue and also to Fire Operational Supplies expenses. 5/yes, 0/no Motion carried

Chief Rob View reported there were 13 medical runs and no fire runs last month. The Burning Ordinance has been rewritten to accommodate DNRE permits. The Easter party is set for April 17 at 2 p.m. Moved by Chase, supported by Davis to accept Rick Davis's application. 4/yes, 1 (Weingartz) no Motion carried Moved by Bentley, supported by Quillen to turn the investigation of Dean Fleminger over to the MI State Police. Quillen/yes, Bentley/yes, Davis/yes, Chase/yes, Weingartz/no Motion carried

Dan Laskey noted that another resident has put up new reflective street sign numbers. He also mentioned that he had run into George and Mary, the couple that our first responders helped recently. They were very grateful with the response and assistance they received.

Chase went to a meeting discussing the liability of mobile homes and the inspections required. Some changes were made.

Guy Santoni questioned our web site and updates posted. We need to update more items regularly.

Allen Champine reported one burial of Maude Eno on February 21. Spring Clean-up of the cemetery will be happening soon.

Total checks written are \$5,621.35 for the General Fund and \$2,051.67 for the Fire Fund. Moved by Quillen, supported by Davis to pay the bills. 5/yes, 0/no Motion carried
