We received CPR mannequins worth \$500 from Ken Scott. In response to Barb Markva's email we will be responding "The members believe there would be too much conflict if she returned." Weingartz questioned what we are doing with the fire truck in Ernie Bentley's barn. It could be restored, sold or scraped out. It was moved by Quillen and supported by Weingartz to try to sell it on EBay after contacting, possibly Dobson in Bay City, to get a value. Weingartz/yes, Davis/yes, Detroyer/yes, Quillen/yes Motion carried Guy Santoni offered to store it until more information regarding value could be found.

Dan Laskey wasn't present. Kay said his next meeting will be September 27.

Quillen contacted our insurance provider to find out that water ball fights would be covered under the training umbrella.

Allen Champine said 'No news is good news'. All is quiet at the cemetery.

Checks written for September were \$4,497.69 from the General Fund and \$1,091.10 from the Fire Fund. It was moved by Quillen and supported by Davis to pay the bills. Quillen/yes, Detroyer/yes, Davis/yes, Weingartz/yes Motion carried

It was moved by Weingartz and supported by Quillen to adjourn. Meeting adjourned at 8:00 p.m.
